

Tablet Setup Guide: Google Play Store & App Download

Part 1: Create a Google Account on Your Tablet

- 1 Turn on your tablet and connect to Wi-Fi
- 2 Open the Settings app
- 3 Scroll down and tap 'Accounts' or 'Users & Accounts'
- 4 Tap 'Add Account'
- 5 Select 'Google'
- 6 Tap 'Create account' and choose 'For myself'
- 7 Enter your name, username (Gmail), and password
- 8 Add your phone number and verify with the code sent
- 9 Enter your birthdate and gender
- 10 Agree to the terms to complete setup

Part 2: Access Google Play Store

- 1 Locate and open the Google Play Store app on your tablet
- 2 Tap your profile icon in the top right corner
- 3 Confirm you are signed in with your new Google account

Part 3: Download Apps from the Play Store

- 1 Tap the search bar at the top of the Play Store
- 2 Type the name of the app you want
- 3 Select the correct app from the list
- 4 Tap 'Install'
- 5 Wait for the app to download and install
- 6 Tap 'Open' or find the app on your home screen

Part 4: Download AD OPS App

- 1 Open the Google Play Store
- 2 Tap the search bar and type 'AD OPS'
- 3 Find the correct AD OPS app in the results
- 4 Tap 'Install'
- 5 Wait for installation to complete
- 6 Tap 'Open' to launch the app

Helpful Tips

- 1 Make sure your tablet is connected to Wi-Fi
- 2 Ensure you have enough storage space
- 3 Allow permissions when prompted for apps to work properly
- 4 Keep your Google account secure with a strong password
